






Sahastra Linga Pujan is a significant and sacred ritual in Hinduism, dedicated to the worship of lord Shiva in the form of the Shivlinga. This puja holds deep spiritual and cultural importance, symbolizing the union of divine energy and consciousness.



"Sahastra" means Thousand. The Pujan of 1000 Parthiv Shivlingam.

The Sahastra Linga Pujan is one of the most sacred and powerful rituals dedicated to Lord Shiva, where 1000 Parthiv Shiv Lings are worshipped. "Parthiv" signifies the earthly element, as these Shiv Lings are made of Holy Mud. This puja has deep roots in ancient Hindu Traditions and holds immense spiritual significance.

In Shiv Mahapurna, Lord Shiva himself instructed devotees to worship the Parthiv Shiv Ling for spiritual progress, purification of sins, and fulfilment of desires.



There are many notable stories associated with Parthiv Shiv Ling Pujan. Lord Rama performed the Parthiv Shiv Ling Puja before embarking on his mission to conquer Lanka and rescue Devi Sita from Ravana, that ling is now revered as 11th Jyothirling in the form of Shri Rameshwaram.



Rishi Markandeya performed this puja with great devotion and received Lord Shiva's grace, which protected him from death itself.



Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj often conducted Parthiv Shiv Ling Pujas to seek blessings for his conquests and the welfare of his kingdom.



Participating in this Puja is considered equivalent to attaining the spiritual merit of One Lakh Surya Grahan. The Parikrama (Circumambulation) of these Sacred Shiv Lings is believed to liberate Devotees from the Cycle of Life and Death, granting them immense devotion and eternal bliss.

Historically, this grand Mahapuja was performed nearly 1000 years ago by King Siddhraj Jaisingh Solanki of Patan, north Gujarat. To honour this sacred event, the king constructed the renowned Rudramal Arch and the holy Sahastra Ling Talav (Pond), which continue to stand as a testament to his devotion and reverence for Lord Shiva.

Participating in a Sahastra Linga Pujan is a once-in-a lifetime chance so come to attain immense spiritual rewards, experience divine connection with Lord Shiva and purify your soul and receive eternal blessings.




